- Listen and ask good questions

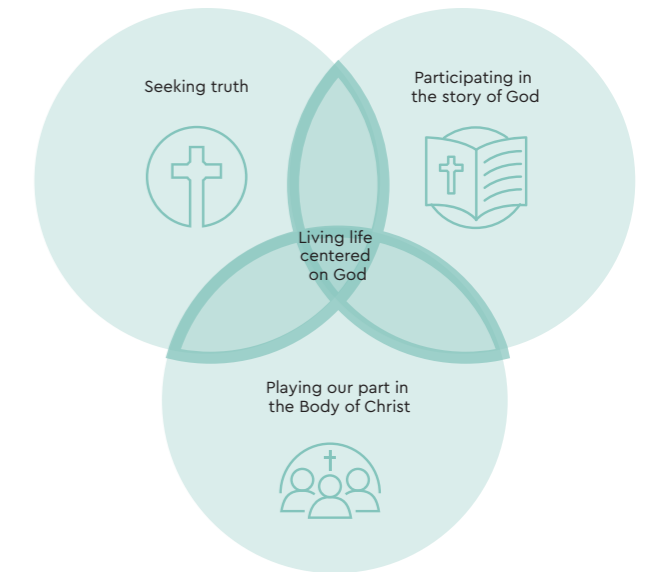
## How we do it
